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RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):

The dispute in this case relates to date of birth of respondent No.1-Gagandeep Singh, who was minor when the litigation was filed in May 2017. Meanwhile, Gagandeep Singh-respondent No.1 has attained the age of majority. He has filed an application under Order 32 Rule 12(2) CPC, 1908, read with Section 151 CPC, seeking leave of the Court to proceed with the matter in his own capacity and not through his natural guardian.

On consideration of the application, the same is allowed and leave is granted. As Gagandeep Singh-respondent No.1 has become major, he has instructed his counsel to make a statement in Court that he is satisfied with his date of birth as recorded in the CBSE record as he has got admission in an institute and is satisfied to pursue his academic career

without any change in date of birth. The statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.1 on instructions from Gagandeep Singh-respondent No.1, is accepted, rendering this petition as infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
