Learned State counsel submits that a status report has been filed in this case. According to which, the petitioner was married on two occasions earlier. His first wife namely Sunita passed away on 19.10.2012. Thereafter, he married a lady namely Kanta Rani who has also passed away however, the date of death was not known. Thereafter, there is no evidence that the petitioner has married for a third time. The police has enquired from the petitioner on a number of occasions to give the whereabouts of his in-laws family but he has failed to do so. Thus, it appears that a false and baseless petition has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to controvert the submissions made on behalf of State counsel, which have

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been made on the basis of the affidavit filed by Dr. Ravjot Grewal, IPS,
Assistant Superintendent of Police, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Thus, it appears that the present petition is totally frivolous and
misconceived and that it appears to have been filed in a fit of delusion. The
same is dismissed. Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is
represented through a legal aid counsel, I refrain from imposing exemplary
costs.
