This application has been filed on behalf of Regional Passport Office, Jalandhar for being impleaded as respondent No.3 in the present case.

Reply in the CM application has not been filed despite availing sufficient opportunities.

In view of the grounds mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and applicant-Regional Passport Office is impleaded as respondent No.3.
