In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is for directing the respondents to promote the petitioner as Municipal Engineer and thereafter to the post of Executive Engineer with effect from the date person junior to him was promoted.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that as per the information dated 24.09.2019 received by office of Advocate General, Haryana from the office of the Principal Secretary to Government of Haryana, Urban Local Bodies Department, the petitioner has already been granted the benefit of promotion as Municipal Engineer with effect from 19.04.2012 and thereafter Executive Engineer w.e.f. 08.03.2019 i.e the date when the persons junior to him were granted promotion. Copy of the promotion order dated 17.07.2019 has also been shown to this Court as well as to learned counsel for the petitioner and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute that the benefit, as being sought in the present writ petition, has already been extended to the petitioner but states that though more than two months have

elapsed since the passing of the promotion order, still the consequential benefits have not been released to the petitioner so far.

Learned counsel for the respondents very fairly states that in case the consequential benefits in pursuance to the order dated 17.07.2019 have not been released, the same will be released within a period of three months from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the statement given on behalf of counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition be disposed of having been not pressed and rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of having been not pressed and rendered infructuous.
