Instant writ petition has been filed assailing the order of termination of the empanelment of the petitioner for the supply of medicines with the C.S.I.R vide order dated 16.5.2017 (Annexure P-8).

Counsel representing the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition so as to take recourse to the remedy of arbitral proceedings.

In the light of such prayer and statement made by counsel, instant writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
