GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is matrimonial discord between petitioner's brother Jagwinder Singh and his wife Amandeep Kaur (Respondent No.6) and that since Jagwinder Singh is residing abroad, the private respondents i.e. the wife of Jagwinder Singh and her relatives are harassing the petitioner so as to pressurize petitioner's brother Jagwinder Singh to come to terms. It has been submitted that on the basis of false complaints, the petitioner is being called to the police Station repeatedly and is being harassed.
2. Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and without

expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala to look into the matter and to dispose of representation (Annexure P-3) expeditiously in accordance with law.

3. Further, in case, the petitioner is required to be associated with any inquiry or investigation or some information is to be elicited from her, then a written advance notice in terms of Section 160 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 be served upon her.
4. A copy of this order along with copy of representation (Annexure P-3) be sent to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
