Prayer in the present petition is to direct respondents no.1 and 2 to arrest respondent no.3, who is a proclaimed offender in 11 complaint cases filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instrument Act.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Inspector, In-charge, PO and Summons Staff, Chandigarh Police, Chandigarh, has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record. In reply, it has been pointed out that search of the premises in which respondent no.3 was expected to be staying, have been carried out but he has already shifted therefrom.

Petitioner, who appears in person, has submitted that he is in knowledge of the correct address of respondent no.3 and he knows much more information about him.

Learned counsel appearing for UT, Chandigarh, has submitted that if the petitioner supplies the aforesaid information to In-charge, PO and Summons Staff, Chandigarh Police, Chandigarh, immediate action shall be taken thereon.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, petitioner is requested to

contact Incharge, PO and Summons Staff, Chandigarh Police, Chandigarh within 2 days and supply entire information. If such information is supplied, it is expected that the Incharge, PO and Summons Staff, Chandigarh Police, Chandigarh, shall immediately take action without any further delay and complete the next proceedings within 15 days thereafter.

In view thereof, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to move an application for revival, if he feels aggrieved by the aforesaid cell.
