Challenge herein, inter-alia, is to the impugned transfer order dated 27.06.2019 (Annexure P-3), vide which the petitioner has been asked to join at Government Medical College, Amritsar from Government Dental College and Hospital, Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been transferred thrice, within a span of 17 days and therefore, the same is causing mental stress, being perceived as stigmatic, for no fault of the petitioner.

2. Having perused the transfer order, I do not find any reason to interfere in the same. The writ petition is accordingly dismissed. However, it is made clear that transfer of the petitioner shall not be construed to be as stigma, as contended by learned counsel for the petitioner.
