On 08.07.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the dispute is with regard to Will of late Sh. Prithvi Raj, father of the petitioner. He submits that the civil suit with regard to succession of Prithvi Raj is already pending. He further submits that the present complaint has been lodged by Smt. Veena Rani, widow of Sh. Lok Raj, brother of late Sh. Prithvi Raj (whose succession is in dispute).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Vikramjit Singh, Addl. AG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana. A copy of the paper book be handed over to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Adjourned to 09.08.2019.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when

called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2), Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view thereof, interim order dated 08.07.2019 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
