By this petition, quashing of FIR No. 15 dated 13.02.2019, is sought registered against the petitioners at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 323, 452, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners (accused) and respondent no. 2, i.e. the complainant.

Vide an order of this Court dated 08.07.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court to get their statements recorded, in terms of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the report of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, has been sent to this Court, in which it is stated that the complainant-respondent no. 2 and the accused-petitioners have both suffered statements to the effect that the matter has been compromised without any fear or pressure on either of them.

In view of the above, in the opinion of this Court, it would be pointless to continue with criminal proceedings, the parties having fully compromised the matter of their own free will.

Consequently, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 15 dated 13.02.2019, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 323, 452, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
