This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of detinue namely Charanjeet Kaur (wife of the petitioner) who was alleged to be in the custody of respondent No.4.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner that the wife is not residing with said respondent No.4. Even the response filed by the State is clear in this regard that the wife travelled in the taxi of respondent No.4 on 28.10.2017, who had dropped her at village Bela on 29.10.2017 at about 5.30 a.m. She had attended the marriage of her niece and she left for Delhi and thereafter ,she never came to village Bela of District Rupnagar.

Learned State counsel has also pointed out that the petitioner has given a statement, wherein he has mentioned that he does not want any action against Kuldeep Singh (respondent No.4).

No other argument was raised by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Since the suspicion in respect of respondent No.4 is over, therefore, the present petition is rendered infructuous.
