By this petition, quashing of FIR No.0145, dated 25.06.2018, is sought registered against the petitioners at Police Station Kotwali Bathinda, District Bathinda, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 279/337/338/427/379/34 IPC, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners (accused) and respondent no.2, i.e. the complainant.

Vide an order of this Court dated 04.07.2019, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court to get their statements recorded, in terms of the compromise.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, the report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda, has been received, to the effect that respondent no.2 (complainant in the FIR) appeared and got recorded his statement to the effect that he has compromised the matter with the petitioners, which as per the assessment of

the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, is not under any undue pressure or coercive.

Thus, keeping in view the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed, the petition is allowed; and FIR No. 0145 dated 25.06.2018, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Kotwali Bathinda, District Bathinda, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 279/337/338/427/379/34 of the IPC, along with all proceedings emanating therefrom, is hereby quashed.
