Grievance of the petitioners is that they have not been accorded the benefit of step up of their salary in order to remove pay anomaly, arising out of their juniors getting higher pay than them, which was granted to them vide order dated 20.09.2017 (Annexure P-7). In the premise, the petitioners also caused legal notice dated 12.04.2019 (Annexure P-9), which has not been adverted to by the respondents till date. Hence the petition.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance service of copy of the petition, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Senior Advocate assisted by Ms. Ambika Bedi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, appears on behalf of respondents.

4. Given the nature of order being passed, there is no necessity to seek return by any of the respondents as no further

proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

5. Without commenting on the merits of case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the legal notice (Annexure P-9) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in this petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
