Prayer made in the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for transferring the investigation of case FIR No. 05 dated 09.01.2019, registered under Sections 420, 406 & 506 IPC at Police Station City-I, Malerkotla, District Sangrur to some senior police officer who may be unbiased.
