In the present writ petition, the claim which is being made by the petitioners is that services of the petitioners, who joined in the year 1987 were regularized w.e.f. 04.05.2006 whereas the employees who joined after them, namely Jagga Ram and Premo Devi, in the year 1990, their services were regularized w.e.f. 01.01.1999.

Even though, nothing has been placed on record to show that juniors of the petitioners have been regularized from the year 1999 but counsel for the petitioner relies upon an order passed by the Principal, Government Senior Secondary School, Jamalpur Seikhon (Fatehabad) dated 12.03.2018 granting pay scale to contend that Sh. Jagga Ram and Premo Devi were granted regularization from the year 1999.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioners have served the respondents with a legal notice dated 25.03.2019 (Annexure P-7) and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioners for the relief which has been claimed by them in the legal notice dated 25.03.2019 (Annexure P-7), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 25.03.2019 (Annexure P-7) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
