The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that there is wilful disobedience of the order dated 2.4.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 27716 of 2017. The said order is reproduced below:

“Petitioner submits that for the grievance raised in this petition, he has also served legal notice. However, no decision has been taken thereon.

Petition is disposed of with the direction that in case legal notice has been received in the office of the concerned authority, same may be looked into and a decision be taken thereon expeditiously, in any case not later than two months.”

As per order dated 2.4.2019, the respondents had to take a decision on the legal notice expeditiously, in any case not later than two months.

Though the time period has already elapsed, at this stage still

another opportunity is provided to the respondents to do the needful within four weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order. In case of failure, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition and the revival would be at the cost and responsibility of the respondents.

With the aforesaid observation, the contempt petition stands disposed of.
