Challenge herein is to the impugned transfer order dated 21.06.2019 (Annexure P-1), whereby the petitioner on his reinstatement, has been transferred from Gurdaspur to Hoshiarpur.

2. I find no illegality in the impugned transfer order in view of the fact that the distance between Gurdaspur and Hoshiarpur is not more than 100 kms. The writ petition is accordingly dismissed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was earlier suspended owing to an FIR registered against him at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, pursuant whereunto criminal proceedings are going on against him at criminal Court at Batala, which causes immense inconvenience to the petitioner at the new place of posting.

4. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner has two marriageable daughters. He is slated to retire in April, 2020 and in normal course he is entitled to the benefit of last leg policy.

4. Keeping in view the above submissions, it is made clear that dismissal of this petition shall not come in way of the respondents taking a lenient view on the representation dated (Annexure P-2) already submitted by the petitioner.
