Present Habeas Corpus petition has been registered on the basis of communication received from petitioner-Jaskaran Singh regarding the illegal detention of his wife, namely Simarjit Kaur alongwith their minor child Navdeep Kaur aged about 2 years in the police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

In response to the notice of motion issued by this Court, status report by way of affidavit of Jagdish Kumar, PPS, D.S.P., Sub Divison, Maur, District Bathinda has been filed and perusal of the same reveals that an FIR No.200 dated 21.09.2018, under Sections 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 was registered against the petitioner and his wife at Police Station Maur, District Bathinda.

In view of the above, custody of the wife of the petitioner cannot be termed as illegal. Consequently, this Court does not find any merit in the present petition and the same is hereby dismissed.

However, observations made above may not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of registration of the FIR referred above.
