Petitioner Karambir @ Amarajit @ Midha has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.168 dated 30.05.2018, registered at Police Station Uchana, District Jind, under Sections 307, 323, 325, 341, 506, 147 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

In the present case, Parvesh is the injured/complainant, who received the injury dangerous to life. He has appeared before the trial Court as a witness and has specifically stated that the persons facing the trial are not the same persons, who had caused injuries to him and this witness has been declared hostile. Two co-accused have already been granted the

benefit of regular bail vide order dated 22.05.2019.

The petitioner has been in custody since 03.06.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case. Otherwise also, he is entitled to the benefit of regular bail on the ground of parity.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
