Main case

Petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.42
dated 16.06.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506 IPC at Police
Station Mulepur, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

As per the case of the prosecution, petitioner alongwith her

husband had collected huge amount from gullible persons who are simpleton villagers under the pretext that they will get higher returns.

As per learned counsel for the State, there are approximately more than 100 FIRs against Crown Credit Cooperative Society Limited.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is wife of Sharanjeet Singh who was working in Crown Credit Cooperative Society Limited.

On reading of the FIR, it is apparent that there are specific allegations against the petitioner to the effect that the petitioner had visited alongwith her husband and induced investors to invest their hard earned money.

In view thereof, no ground for granting concession of pre-arrest bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
