The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in DDR No. 31 dated 22.03.2019, registered under Sections 182, 194, 195, 203, 34 of the IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of the Arms Act in FIR No. 45 dated 20.03.2019 under Sections 307, 34 of the IPC, registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

The operative part of the order dated 04.07.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that it is case of version and cross version and in the main FIR No.45 dated 20.3.2019 under Sections 307/34 IPC registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot recorded at the instance of the petitioner, he has recorded that some unknown persons has fired upon him, whereas in the DDR version, it is stated that the petitioner himself shoot on his chest with a country made pistol.

It is further submitted that the manner in which

the DDR has been registered, it is suggested that the petitioner has suffered grievous injuries, whereas the DDR was registered at the instance of one Mohit Kumar @ Manni, who sworn an affidavit that he had not given any such statement to the police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 04.07.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Surinderjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 04.07.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
