This petition is directed against the order dated 26.06.2019
passed by the Commissioner, SAS Nagar (Mohali).

The following order was passed by this Court on 21.08.2019:-

*“Counsel for the respondent has submitted that as per his
instructions, the present writ petition may be disposed of by
giving a direction to the Trial Court to decide the suit filed by
the petitioner under Section 11 of the Punjab Village Commons
Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 expeditiously and in a time bound
manner and till then order of status quo may be maintained.*

*Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for a short
accommodation to seek instructions in this regard.*

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that instructions have
been received for disposal of the writ petition by directing the trial Court,

seized of the suit filed under Section 11 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (for short “the Act”), expeditiously and till then order of *status quo* may be maintained.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the Court, seized of the suit filed by the respondent under Section 11 of the Act, to decide the same as early as possible preferably within six months from the date of passing of this order and till then *status quo* be maintained.

It is needless to mention that learned trial Court shall not be influenced by this order while deciding on merits.
