Petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and his family members from the hands of respondents No.4 and 17. They further pray for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 3 to take departmental action against respondents No.4 and 5, who allegedly in connivance with respondents No.6 and 17 and their associates tried to take forcible possession of the land.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Avtar Singh has invited the attention of the Court to para 2 of the reply filed by way of affidavit of Piara Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub

Division Shahkot, District Jalandhar, dated 28.8.2019, wherein it is mentioned that on the complaint given by the petitioners, FIR No.55 dated 16.5.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 447, 511, 506, 341, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar Rural already stands registered at the instance of Smt. Krishna (respondent No.7) and on the statement of petitioner No.1 a cross version has been registered for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 341, 511, 148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar Rural.

In view of this, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press this petition at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed.
