This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr. P.C., for quashing of criminal complaint Case No. 225 of 2016 dated 05.02.2007, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120B of IPC, pending before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Mahendergarh (Annexure P-1) and the order framing of charges dated 27.02.2017 (inadvertently typed as 27.02.2007 in the head note of petition).

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned counsel that after framing of charge, the prosecution witnesses have been recalled for cross-examination on the request of defence. Some of the witnesses have been cross-examined and now the case is fixed for further cross-examination of the remaining witnesses on 07.09.2019.

Admittedly, the complaint is of dated 24.12.2007 and the trial is at an advanced stage, therefore, this Court does not find any valid reason for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr. P.C.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed.
