The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 57 dated 29.05.2019, under Sections 452, 323, 148, 149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur.

The operative part of the order dated 08.07.2019, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that all the offences except Section 452 IPC are bailable. It is further submitted that as per MLR of the injured person, injuries sustained by him are simple in nature. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioners are first offenders and they are ready to join the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Satnam Singh, submits that the petitioners be directed to join the investigation.

List again on 01.08.2019.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 08.07.2019, have already appeared before

the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Sita Ram, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 08.07.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
