As already recorded in the order dated 27.8.2019, the report of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula, is on record, stating to the effect that the statements of the parties, i.e. the petitioner and respondents no.2 and 3 (Caamin Arora, and Sunita Sharma & Vaishali Sharma respectively), were recorded before that Court to the effect that the parties have in fact compromised the matter with each other.

As per the assessment of the learned CJM, the compromise has been arrived at without any undue influence or pressure.

Today, learned counsel for respondents no.2 and 3 has also appeared and has filed 'his power of attorney', which is ordered to be taken on record. He does not dispute the factum of the compromise having been arrived at between the parties.

That being so, looking at the nature of the offences alleged to have been committed, the petition is allowed with FIR no.75 registered at

Police Station Sector 14, Panchkula, on 18.4.2018, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 279/337 of the IPC, along with all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, is hereby quashed.
