Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a criminal complaint No.89 dated 17.08.2018 titled as ***Jasbir Singh Versus Captain Singh and others*** under Sections 302, 120-B and 306 read with Section 34 IPC filed by respondent No.2-complainant before learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Batala.
