The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.89, dated 27.04.2019, under Sections 323, 341, 506 of IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Samrala, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations are politically motivated as the petitioner has lost the election of Sarpanch and has been falsely implicated at the behest of the successful candidate. He also contends that seven co-accused have been granted anticipatory bail.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner are that while he was armed with an iron *dah*, he had given a blow on the head of Kalia. He had also caused injuries to Satnam Singh on his shoulder.

In view of the seriousness of the allegations against the petitioner, especially of having caused a head injury on Kalia with an iron *dah*, he is not

entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail. However, the other co-accused, who have been granted anticipatory bail, have not caused any injury on the head or vital part of the body of the injured.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.
