Sukhpal Singh @ Toti has sent this complaint by post, wherein, it is alleged that his elder daughter Manpreet Kaur, who is 10+2, was sent to Singapore for work. His daughter left for Singapore and after some time, Sandeep Singh @ Sipu called his daughter back to India on false allurements.

It is further alleged that her daughter has called him and narrated that she was being kept in a rented room and was treated with cruelty. It was prayed that his daughter Manpreet Kaur be got released from the accused Sandeep Singh @ Sipu.

The said communication was treated as a criminal writ petition No.940 of 2018.

Pursuant to notice issued on 28.11.2018, Mr. Rahul Rampal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of Manpreet Kaur and apprised the Court that she is living with her husband Sandeep Singh @ Sipu.

Learned State counsel has also filed the status report by way of affidavit of Iqbal Singh, PPS, Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, wherein it is indicated that daughter of petitioner has solemnized marriage with Sandeep Singh and had filed a petition i.e. CRM-M-49695 of 2018, whereby direction was issued by this Court to the Superintendent of Police, UT Chandigarh to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication as the petition has been rendered infructuous.
