Counsel alleges false implication of the petitioner in FIR No.40 dated 11.03.2019 registered under Section 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran. There are categorical averments made in the petition as regards harassment and blackmailing at the hands of respondent No.5 i.e. SHO/Inspector Incharge CIA Staff, Tarn Taran.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition and without going into the merits and demerits of the case, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the Senior Superintendent of Police Tarn Taran as regards his grievance including false implication.

In the eventuality of any such application being made, respondent No.4 would be obligated to look into the matter and to take steps if any, as he may deem fit.
