ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.86 dated 02.04.2019, under Sections 379-A IPC (Section 120-B IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Urban Estate, Hisar District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations in the FIR are that at the behest of the petitioner, the co-accused Anil had snatched bag from the complainant which contained Rs.29,000/- cash and other articles. The petitioner is in custody for over 7 months and is not involved in any other case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from HC Subhash, states that the charges have been framed and 3 out of 7 witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 7 months, he is not involved in any other case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
