The petitioner has approached this Court seeking issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 5 to conduct a fair and impartial inquiry into the complaints dated 8.3.2019 (Annexure P-6 to P-8) and to register a criminal case against respondent No.6 and her parents/relatives.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.6 by misrepresenting about her marital status, without getting her marriage dissolved got employment in the Punjab Police and that although the petitioner had made a complaint to the concerned authorities but no action has been taken thereupon.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting anything on merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka (respondent No.3) to look into the matter and to dispose of the representation Annexure P-7 in accordance with law.

A copy of this order along with copy of representation Annexure P-7 be sent to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka (respondent No.3) so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
