The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.334 dated 05.06.2019 under Sections 82/83 of Indian Registration Act, 1908, registered at Police Station City Hansi.

The operative part of the order dated 09.07.2019, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that much prior to registration of this FIR, the State of Haryana has filed a civil suit against the petitioner, which was dismissed as withdrawn on 23.02.2017 and the Court granted permission to the State to file fresh suit on the same cause of action. It is further submitted that the petitioner has challenged the aforesaid order by way of filing CR No.2608 of 2017 and the same is pending and in the meantime, the State has filed another suit, which is still pending and the present FIR has been registered after a delay of 09 years....”

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 09.07.2019, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Vijender Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 09.07.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
