By these two separate petitions filed by each of the petitioners under Section 439 Cr.P.C., they seek the concession of 'regular bail'.

The petitioners not having been identified in the initial statement made by the complainant leading to the registration of the FIR, with it stated that the persons who snatched Rs.3 lacs from him and attacked him all had muffled faces and were travelling on a motor-cycle without a number plate, and the petitioners already having been in custody for 1 month and 20 days, without making any comment on the merits of the case

for or against the petitioners, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioners on bail during the pendency of the trial.

It is to be noticed that as per the custody certificates filed in Court today, there are no other cases shown to be registered against both the petitioners.

Consequently, this petition is allowed. The petitioner would be enlarged on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
