The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 266/227 of the Constitution of India is to the E-auction notice dated 09.04.2018 published in the 'Indian Express' dated 09.04.2018 at page No.5 (**Annexure P-9**). Further prayer has also been made to direct the respondents to decide the representations (**Annexures P-1 & P-2**) sympathetically and to release the property mortgaged with them.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent-Bank, on instructions from Mr. Gaurav, Law Officer, Bank of Baroda, submitted that the matter has been amicably settled. The up-front money has been deposited by the petitioner and one time settlement has been accepted by the Bank.
