JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the official respondents to promote the petitioner from the post of OC to the post of SSA w.e.f. 15.10.2014, the date from which his junior respondent No.5 stood promoted.

At this stage, the learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 to 4 submits that the necessary relief has been allowed to the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the statement made above, the present petition is disposed of accordingly.

However, in case, any grouse of the petitioner is still left unaddressed, the petitioner shall have the liberty to file representation before the competent authority within eight weeks from the date of receipt

of the certified copy of this judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of eight weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
