Petitioner was released on furlough for a period of 21 days on 14.6.2019 till 5.7.2019. Petitioner sought extension of the parole stating that on 29.6.2019 he had severe pain in his left side of the chest which was radiating to the left arm with associated perspiration, palpitation, extreme sweating, restlessness, nausea etc. He was admitted in JJ Institute of Medical Sciences Bahadurgarh.

Reply of the State was sought. Learned State counsel has filed reply in Court today. The same is taken on record. State in the reply has submitted that the petitioner was discharged from JJ Institute of Medical Sciences Bahadurgarh on 6.7.2019 in a stable condition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was again admitted in the said hospital on 15.7.2019 with complaint of severe

pain in abdomen, recurrent vomiting, giddiness, palpitation etc.

In these circumstances, the petitioner is directed to surrender before Jail authorities on 17.7.2019 till 4.00 p.m. In case, he makes complaint of some medical problem, the jail authorities shall get him examined from the Medical Board to find out as to whether he is medically unfit and needs treatment and if there is any disease, treatment of the same is available in the jail or not and if the same is not available in the jail, jail authorities shall take necessary steps for the said treatment.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
