By this second petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

The petitioner admittedly not having been apprehended at the spot and as per the case of the investigating agency, identified by a Constable of the police party that is stated to have recovered tablets thrown away by him from a polythene bag, and he having been in custody for about 10 months, with the trial nowhere near conclusion and with no other criminal case shown to be registered against him, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
