Petitioners seek a Mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect their life and liberty by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of private respondents no.4 and 5, who happen to be the parents of petitioner no.2.

Counsel very fairly concedes that petitioner no.2 is a minor aged 16 years. He further submits that even though both the petitioners have entered into matrimony but after filing of the instant petition the parents of petitioner no.2 have taken her back and she is now staying in her parental home. An FIR is stated to have been lodged against petitioner no.1 at the hands of respondent no.5.

Under such circumstances, there would be no occasion for this Court to entertain the prayer made in the instant petition.

Petition is dismissed.
