This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful
disobeyance of order dated 8.4.2019 passed in CRM-M-No.15997 of 2019.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

*"Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and
without commenting anything on merits of the case, the
petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent of
Police, Kaithal, District Kaithal (respondentNo.2) to look into
the matter and to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-5)
expeditiously, in accordance with law.*

*A copy of this order along with copy of representation
Annexure P-5 be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Kaithal,
District Kaithal (respondent No.2) so as to enable him to do
the needful expeditiously."*

It has been pleaded that the order was communicated to the
respondent on 16.4.2019 and thereafter contempt notice was served on
9.5.2019.

In the above quoted order, the direction was not time bound but
was to decide the representation expeditiously.

No case is made out for initiating contempt proceedings at this stage.

However, there is no doubt that the respondent will comply with the order passed by this Court in its letter and spirit.
