Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 222 dated 7.12.2018 registered under Section 21 of NDPS Act at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar.

Alleged recovery of 255 grams of Heroin from the petitioner falls in commercial quantity. Case is now fixed for 24.10.2019 for recording of evidence of six prosecution witnesses out of total 10 witnesses proposed to be examined.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody, learned Trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and make a sincere endeavour to conclude the same within four months.

At this stage, this Court does not find it proper to release the petitioner on bail.
