Present petition under Section 439 of the Criminal Procedure Code is for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Sukhdev Singh son of Prem Nath in case F.I.R. No.29 dated 27.02.2019 under Sections 379-B, 324, 451, 506 and 511 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City, Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contended that the petitioner is in custody since 27.02.2019 and challan has been presented in this case. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case, who was working as a painter at the residence of the complainant and because of some dispute regarding payment, he has been falsely implicated. Trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, so he be released on bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dilbagh Singh, opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that the petitioner was apprehended red-handed at the spot and he had caused injuries, so no case is made out for grant of regular bail to the petitioner and the present petition be dismissed.

At this stage, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, which may not cause prejudice to either of the parties at a later stage, but taking the above facts into consideration and the fact the petitioner is in custody since 27.02.2019; trial of the case still to take some more time and no useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioner behind the bars, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner—Sukhdev Singh, is ordered to be admitted to regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned learned trial Judge/ Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate.
