The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 14.5.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 12625 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Petition is disposed of with a direction that the legal notice, Annexure P-7 be considered by the concerned authority within two weeks. In case, adverse order is passed, same be conveyed to the petitioner.”

Short reply by way of affidavit of Udaydeep Singh, PCS, Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Bathinda filed today in court is taken on record. Along with the reply, order dated 19.8.2019 has been annexed, wherein it has been held that Regional Transport Authority, Bathinda has been advised to implement the order of State Transport Appellate Tribunal, Punjab and issue one stage carriage permit for plying one return trip daily on the route in question in favour of the petitioner

subject to the condition that lien over the said permit shall be of Punjab Roadways, Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he prays that temporary stage carriage permit should be issued to the petitioner expeditiously.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Vivek Rattan, Clerk in the office of Regional Transport Authority, Bathinda, submits that the same would be done within four weeks from today.

In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of.
