The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 14.5.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 12578 of 2019. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Petition is disposed of with a direction that the legal notice, Annexure P-7 be considered by the concerned authority within two weeks. In case, adverse order is passed, same be conveyed to the petitioner.”

Short reply by way of affidavit of Dilraj Singh, IAS, State Transport Commissioner, Punjab filed in court today is taken record. Along with the reply, order dated 16.8.2019 has been annexed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the order dated 16.8.2019, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance

with law against the order passed.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty aforesaid.
