Learned counsel for the appellant has contended that he could not contact his client despite repeated efforts. He has further contended that driver has been acquitted in criminal case and it so seems that parties have arrived at a compromise. It is further submitted that the present appeal be dismissed in default with the observations that in case the necessity arises the same may be revived.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the appellant, the appeal stands dismissed in default with liberty to the appellant to apply for its restoration, if necessity arises.
