JITENDRA CHAUHAN.J.(ORAL)

This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ, in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to release the amount of Rs.14,50,000/- along with interest.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Divisional Engineer, Lining Division No.2, Punjab Water Resources Management and Development Corporation Limited, Punjab to consider and decide the legal notice dated 09.02.2018 (Annexure P-3).

Learned counsel for the respondents states that he is not averse to the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Divisional Engineer, Lining Division No.2, Punjab Water Resources Management and Development Corporation Limited, Punjab to consider and decide the legal notice dated 09.02.2018 (Annexure P-3) within six weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to it, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to it, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
