In Para 9 of the reply filed by the Punjab Agro Food Grain Corporation Ltd., it has been stated that payment of Rs.50,36,793.75/- has already been transferred into the bank account of M/s Surinder Paul Jaggiwan Ram, the petitioner-firm on 07.01.2017. This petition is dated 03.01.2017. It came up for hearing for the first time on 11.01.2017 when notice of motion was issued to the respondent-Corporation with the next date fixed for 31.01.2017. No one has appeared in this case for the petitioner-firm since 05.03.2018, the dates in between by orders as the case come up for hearings. Today, neither the petitioner nor its counsel have put in appearance which convinces me that payments have been made when the matter was rendered infructuous even before notice of motion was issued.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as infructuous.
