This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 1.3.2019 passed in CWP No. 5695 of 2019.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"In view of the above, without advertng to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 - Deputy Commissioner, Kaithal to consider and decide the representations dated 16/27.11.2018 and 20.2.2019 (Annexures P-5 and P-6) within six weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the judgment. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of six weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter."

Learned counsel for the petitioners during the course of hearing fairly submits that personal hearing has been granted to the petitioners on 15.5.2019 for taking decision on the representation.

At this stage no case is made out for contempt.

However, there is no doubt that atleast now the respondent would be aware that the direction issued by this Court were time bound.
