The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 28.1.2019 passed by this Court in CWP No. 2236 of 2019. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Without going into the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate order on the representation dated 18.9.2018 (Annexure P-4) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the said representation, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.”

As per the order, the respondents were directed to pass an

appropriate order on the representation dated 18.9.2018, within a period of

three months from the receipt of certified copy of the order. There is nothing on record to show as to when certified copy of the order was served upon the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the contempt petition at this stage to serve certified copy of the order dated 28.1.2019 on the respondents.

Dismissed as withdrawn at this stage. There is no doubt that in case the needful is done, the respondents would consider the fact that the directions given to them to were to decide in time bound manner.
