Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 read with Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Gulshan Kumar and Bikram Kumar @ Vicky in a criminal complaint No.146 dated 30.11.2016 (Annexure P-1) titled as ***Sheela Devi Versus Gulshan Kumar and another*** under Sections 452, 354, 323, 324, 427 and 506 IPC and Section 3(1) (X) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 filed by respondent No.1-complainant before learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.
